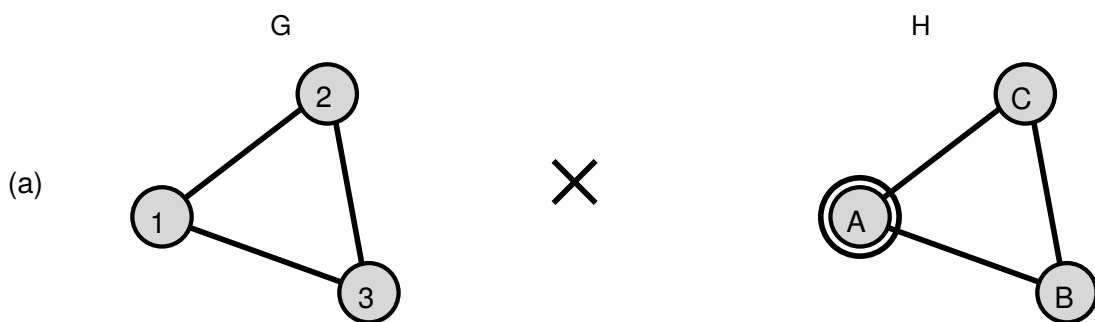

of the following pair of graphs (in the order given), where node A is the root of H where relevant.



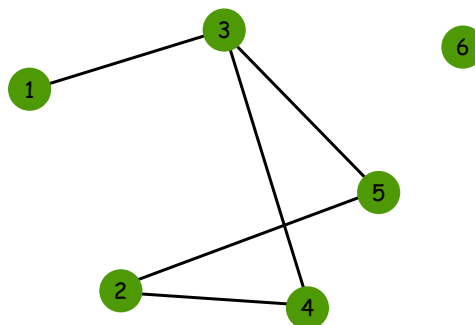
